If you would like to request a space on campus to hold an in person handover meeting, please drop us an events notification form and we will e happy to help you facilitate


HANDOVER AND REAFFILIATION

You should hopefully all be considering handover and reaffiliation at this time of year, especially now that the byelections have finished. Please note, if you did not manage to fill your core roles by now, that your student group WILL be dissafiliated. If your not sure what this means, please drop us an email!

The first document to be aware of is the handover document. as shown on the right. This document will need to be filled out and sent to us via this form by the 30th June and is COMPULSORY towards your affiliation.

Handover is the process where the outgoing committee teaches the incoming committee about their roles. This ensures each committee member is prepared for the coming year and knows what to expect from their role.

There are 2 other reaffiliation documents that must be considered - master risk assessment and the constitution. However, these do not need to be submitted until the 31st July. More information on this can be found in the committee welcome emails you should have/will be receiving.
