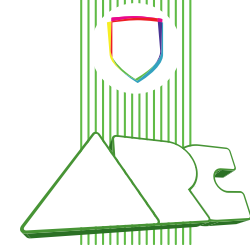


Nourish is where you can pick up a great lunch, your daily paper or some groceries. It will be where the Union Shop is now, but... sideways!
