Media Groups

Ripple Editor

- Main representative of the University of Leicester's Student Newspaper
- Proof Read and Edit the final copy of the Ripple newspaper
- Organize the design, content, printing and distribution of The Ripple
- Look to work with the other Media groups within the Student Union and other university organizations.
- Assign sub editor positions
- Decide on relevant training sessions for sub editor/ writers
- Chair meetings between Sub Editors

LUST Director General

- Be the point of contact for the LUST exec team (which includes a director of programming, a technical manager, a head of marketing etc)
- Organize filming and editing teams (for events such as Battle of the Dances and Varsity)
- Get new people involved and make sure new ideas for TV Shows are put into motion
- Take care of administrative tasks such as replying to emails, fill out forms to hire equipment etc
- Provide training for new members

LUST Assistant Director General

- Deputise for the Director as and when required and to co-ordinate the preparations of LUST broadcasts by giving assistance and advice in all areas of LUST

LUSH Controller

- Be the Premier representative of the LUSH radio station
- Organise the Radio Schedule for live shows
- Assign the relevant committee positions
- Chair meeting with the LUSH Committee
- Organise Sponsorship/ advertising for the Radio Station

Deputy LUSH Controller

- Deputise for the Station Controller as and when required and in addition to co-ordinate the preparations of LUSH RADIO broadcasts by giving assistance and advice in all areas of LUSH radio.

Web Master

- Work alongside members of staff to develop and enhance the Students' Union website.
- Maintain an up to date website, with particular respect to events and developments within student groups, the Union, University and local and national news that affect students and the services available to them.
