AFFILIATION DOCUMENTS

The next deadline for you all to be aware of is the 31st July, when all of your affiliation documents need to be submitted. You must submit your documents via this form.

If you are yet to submit your committee handover, please ensure it is done by this date alongside the MRA, constitution and development goal confirmation form.

Please be aware of these common reasons why documents are refused before submitting:

- Using the 23/24 document templates. Please ensure that you are using the updated 24/25 document templates that can be found via this page.
- Submitting typed signatures. We can only accept signatures that are in wet form. You can do this by photocopying a written signature or using websites such as DocuSign.

UPDATED HANDBOOK

We have now released the updated committee handbook as of the 18th July 2024!

FRESHERS FAIR SIGN UP

We are now in the process of organising Societies/Sports Club promotional opportunities in September 2024 as part of Freshers (Welcome Week)!

This <u>sign up form</u> has been built as an expression of interest so we can gauge which Student Groups would like to take part in promotional activity linked to the Students' Union over Freshers, the sign up deadline will be **Sunday 1st of September 2024**.

If your group cannot fully complete your (re-)affiliation in time or decides to join after this deadline, you will **not** be able to participate in the event.; upon discretion, we may confirm your stall a week or a few days before the fair should there be any availability.

This year, we will be putting societies and clubs on separate days as the Societies Fair and Sports Fair, and this will be happening on:

- Wednesday 25th September 2024, 10:00-16:00 in the Percy Gee Building Societies Fair

Your group will be assigned to one of the above days, however if your society/club is only available on a different day, we will try to accommodate the request, but it may not be guaranteed.

TERM DATES CONSULTATION

The University is seeking your views on potential changes to the academic year structure.

The University has an established model for setting term and semester dates and the associated pattern of the academic calendar. Education Committee, which is responsible for recommending term and semester dates to Senate for approval, has been considering potential amendments that could be made to the academic year structure in the short term, to alleviate the pressures felt in some areas in January. While large-scale changes are not currently under consideration, the Committee is also looking at whether a full-scale review of the academic year structure is needed, which may result in more significant changes in the longer term.

COUNCIL APPLICATIONS 24/25

Next Monday the 29th July at 10am, the applications will open for the student group and voice councils 24/25!

In 24/25 there will be 3 councils and 2 networks sat underneath them, that are made up by student leaders like yourself and chaired by an executive officer. They are split into two groups: student group councils and voice councils. You can read more about each council here:

STUDENT GROUP COUNCILS

Societies Council - Societies Council is chaired by the sports and societies officer and works to ensure the voices and opinions of all areas of student groups at Leicester are equally considered in the implementation of decisions and changes at the SU. The roles are open to all student group members not just committee members so please send this information onto your members too.

In 24/25 the council will be broken down into 11 roles and individual responsibilities. More information on the different roles and the requirements of the council can be found here. The form to apply from the 29^{th} July is <u>linked here</u>.

Sports Council - Sports Council aims to give students across all facets of club sport a greater voice here. The future success of sports here at Leicester lies completely within the student's voices. This council helps to lead on navigating the forthcoming season as we build on creating an exceptional sporting offer and ensuring the success of sports clubs in 24/25. The roles are open to all sports club members, you do not need to be part of a committee or from a Team Leicester group, so please send this information onto your members too!

In 24/25 the council will be broken down into 9 roles and individual responsibilities. More information on the different roles and the requirements of the council can be found here. The form to apply from the 29th July is linked here.

Creative Network – Creative Network (formerly known as Creative Council), works to support the empowerment of the arts here at Leicester, creating a platform for creatives and performers within student groups to get involved with decision making and changes within the Students' Union. The roles are open to all creative/performance group members, you do not need to be part of a committee so please send this information onto your members too!

In 24/25 the network will be broken down into 8 roles and individual responsibilities. More information on the different roles and the requirements of the council can be found here. The form to apply from the 29th July is linked here.

VOICE COUNCILS

Liberation Council - The Liberation Council is set out to formalise student discussions, build a inclusivity-focused working group within the SU and discuss ideas, campaigns and events that give students from minorities and protected characteristic groups, a greater voice. The council is broken down into multiple roles with individual responsibilities and is chaired by the liberation officer. These roles are open to all students whether they are part of a student group or not.

Sustainability Network - Sustainability Network (formerly known as Green Bubble) is our main Student Sustainability Forum, where we feedback on what we can do to help with issues like health and wellbeing, energy, travel, reducing waste and Activism at the University, in the Students' Union and beyond. This council is open to all students, not just student group members, and is chaired by the community and wellbeing officer.

In 24/25 the network will be broken down into 6 roles and individual responsibilities. More information on the different roles and the requirements of the council can be found here. The form to apply from the 29th July is linked here.
